Board Certification.

In order to consider you for Board Certification, you are required to submit the following documents with a payment of Board Certification fee of Rs: 10,000.00, which can be made to any branch of the Bank of Ceylon to the credit of our Acc. No. 0380202174 at the Bank of Ceylon, Borella Branch.

1. Certified copy of the paying-in-voucher form (pink form) confirming the payment of Board Certification fee of Rs: 10,000.00
2. a letter of application from you for Board Certification.
3. a report from the overseas trainer on satisfactory completion of your training period.
4. a report from your local trainer on satisfactory completion of your training period.
5. a letter from your employer regarding your date of resumption of duties.
6. a no claim certificate from the Deputy Registrar, PGIM.
7. a no claim certificate from the Librarian, PGIM
8. if a PGIM sponsored trainee, a no claim certificate from the Deputy Bursar, PGIM.

On receipt of the above documents, action will be taken to consider you for Board Certification, which normally takes more than 3 months.

In addition to the above,

Anaesthesiology trainees are required to submit a report on their outstation Senior Registrar appointment, Chronic pain report, study or audit.

Surgery trainees are required to submit their log book with the documents and interviewed by the Board of Study on the day Board Certification is considered.

Paediatric trainees are interviewed by the Board of Study on the day Board Certification is considered.

Obstetrics & Gynaecology trainees are required to make a 15 minutes presentation on overseas training to the Board of Study on the day Board Certification is considered.

Community Medicine trainees are required to make a 15 minutes presentation on overseas training to the Board of Study on the day Board Certification is considered.

Radiology trainees are interviewed by the Board of Study on the day Board Certification is considered.

Dermatology trainees are interviewed by the Board of Study on the day Board Certification is considered.

Microbiology trainees are interviewed by the Board of Study after confirmation of minutes.

Oral Surgery & Restorative Dentistry trainees are required to submit a case book.

Psychiatry trainees are required to submit a dissertation.

Clinical Oncology trainees are required to submit a dissertation.

Any other stipulation a specific Board of Study may introduce with the approval of the Board of Management from time to time.
